

# Luxembourg

There were 22 investment projects recorded in France from Luxembourg businesses in 2024, including 17 that created or maintained 284 jobs. Luxembourg recorded an increase of 29% in the number of projects compared with 2023.

## They chose France in 2024

**Eurofins:** Eurofins is a Luxembourg group specializing in analyses. The Saint-Augustin site, in the Nouvelle Aquitaine region, carries out quality control and stability monitoring activities for pharmaceutical products. The firm has invested €5 million in the construction of a new pharmaceutical building and 2,500 cubic meters of climatic chambers, tripling the site's storage capacities. This investment will safeguard the future of the site and will create 20 jobs.

## Luxembourg investments in France

The FDI stock<sup>1</sup> of businesses from Luxembourg in France is around €58 billion, making Luxembourg the sixth country with the largest FDI stock in France.

There were 22 job-creating investment decisions recorded from Luxembourg in France in 2024, including 17 that created or maintained 284 jobs. Luxembourg recorded an increase of 29% in the number of projects compared with 2023.

The majority of projects (59%) and jobs (68%) were related to manufacturing activities, followed by R&D activities (18%) and consumer services (9%).

Sector-wise, projects from Luxembourg were mainly intended for the metalworking sector (36%). Luxembourg was the fourth country to have invested the most in this sector, with 11% of all projects recorded in metalworking in 2024. The chemicals/plastics and medical equipment/devices sectors each made up 18% of projects.

Ten French regions hosted projects originating from Luxembourg in 2024, notably Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes (18%), Hauts de France (18%) and Bourgogne-Franche-Comté (14%).

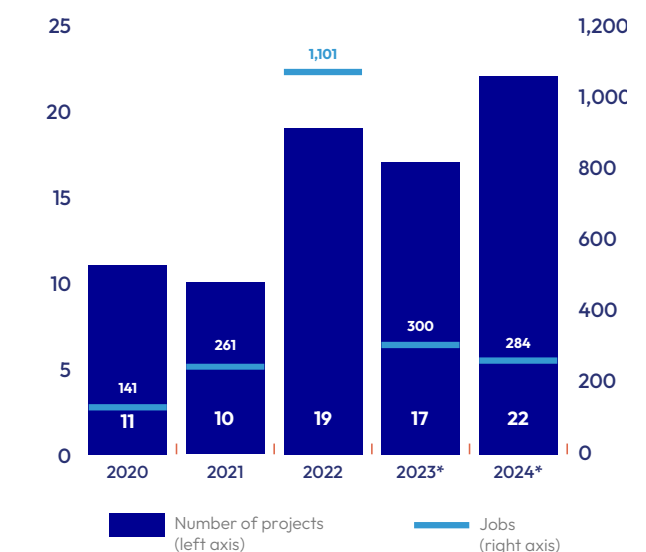
