



# Latin America

In 2024, 25 new investment projects in France from Latin American businesses¹ were recorded, generating 666 jobs, with 64% of projects and 71% of jobs coming from Mexico, ahead of Brazil.

## They chose France in 2024

its European decision center in Toulouse, where it plans to recruit a team of 30 employees within three years, which should expand to 50 people within five years.

#### Latin American investments in France

The FDI stock² of businesses from Latin America in France is around €4.6 billion.

In 2024, 25 new investment projects from this area were recorded in France, enabling 666 jobs to be created. Most of these projects were from Mexico (64%), followed by Brazil (16%).

More than one in two projects were in retail outlets (56%), which also accounted for 48% of the jobs created in France by Latin American countries, followed by decision–making centers (24%) and production/manufacturing projects (8%).

The hospitality, tourism and restaurants sector accounted for more than half of the projects (56%) and jobs (53%) announced by Latin American businesses. In addition, these projects amounted to nearly half of all projects (45%) and jobs (48%) in the sector announced in 2024. The pharmaceuticals and biotechnologies sector received 8% of projects. Also of note was that a single project in the agri-food sector alone accounted for 16% of the jobs created by Latin American businesses.

The majority of projects were located in Ile de France (Paris region) (40%), followed by Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes (12%) and Nouvelle Aquitaine (8%).


